

Developmental Screening (2011)

Benchmarks to qualify for bonus payments: This measurement has separate benchmarks for different age ranges. The bonus will be determined for each age group independently.

- 65% of children with one developmental screening by the age of 12 months.
- 55% of children with one developmental screening between the ages of 12 and 24 months.
- 50% of children with one developmental screening between the ages of 24 and 36 months.

Measurement Period: 12 months prior to the 12, 24, or 36 month birthday respectively.

Qualifying Service: CPT codes 96110 or 96111. (For more information on qualifying tools review the Health Kids Provider Handbook, section HK203.53 at <http://www.hfs.illinois.gov/handbooks/chapter200.html#hk200>).

Qualifying Patient: Any child on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster on December 1, 2011, that turns 12, 24 or 36 months in that calendar year.
