

Diabetes Management

Benchmark to qualify for bonus payments: At least 79.3% of patients with diabetes, age 18 to 65 years, had a Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) testing during the measurement year on or before December 31, 2008.

Measurement Period: Calendar year 2008

Qualifying Service: CPT Codes 83036 or 83037

Qualifying Patient: Patients on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster as of December 1, 2008 will be identified as a member with diabetes if they:

- Had **two** face-to-face encounters with different dates of service in an **outpatient/office visit** setting with **diagnosis of diabetes** (ICD-9 codes 250, 357.2, 362.0x, or 366.41.) during the measurement year (CY) or the year prior to the measurement year (CY); or
- Had **one** face-to-face encounter in an **inpatient** or **emergency department (ED)** setting with **diagnosis of diabetes** (ICD-9 codes 250, 357.2, 362.0x, or 366.41.) during the measurement year (CY) or the year prior to the measurement year (CY).
