

Immunizations Combo 3 (2011)

Benchmark to qualify for bonus payments: At least 71.0% of enrolled two year old children are appropriately immunized with combo 3: (4) DTaP; (3) IPV; (1) MMR; (3) Hib; (2) HepB; (1) chicken pox vaccine (VZV); (4) pneumococcal conjugate [(4- 3 -1 -3 - 2- 1- 4)]. (Although Combo 3 includes three HepB, for this measure HFS is requiring only two as the first HepB is assumed given to newborns in the hospital before discharge and HFS cannot yet isolate that data.)

Measurement Period: Birth through the child's second birthday.

Qualifying Patient: Any child on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster on December 1, 2011 that turns 24 months in calendar year 2011.

Qualifying Service: Immunization Codes Table (Data will be obtained from HFS claims and public health related immunization reporting systems, i.e., Cornerstone, TOTS, ICARE etc.)
