

## Breast Cancer Screening (2014)

Benchmark to qualify for bonus payments: At least 51.53% (50<sup>th</sup> percentile) or 57.85% (75<sup>th</sup> percentile) of women between 50 and 74 years of age had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer between the dates of October 1 two years prior to the measurement year through December 31 of the measurement year.

Measurement Period: Calendar years 2012, 2013 and 2014.

Qualifying Service: CPT Codes 77055, 77056, 77057; HCPCS G0202, G0204, G0206; Diagnosis codes 87.36, 87.37; UB-92 Revenue code 0401, 0403

Note: Does not include biopsies, breast ultrasounds, MRIs, or other diagnostic mammograms as they are not appropriate methods for primary breast cancer screening.

Qualifying Patient: Women on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster as of December 1, 2014 between the ages of 52 and 74 as of December 31 of measurement year.

Exclusions: Women who had a bilateral mastectomy with supporting evidence anytime as far back as possible in the woman's history through December 31, 2014. See table below for codes to identify exclusions. Any of the following meet criteria for bilateral mastectomy:

- A bilateral mastectomy code.
- A unilateral mastectomy code with a bilateral modifier.
- Two unilateral mastectomy codes on different dates of service.
- A unilateral mastectomy code with a right side modifier and a unilateral mastectomy code with a left side modifier (may be on the same date of service).
