

Developmental Screening (2013)

Benchmarks to qualify for bonus payments: This measurement has separate benchmarks for different age ranges. The bonus will be determined for each age group independently.

- 85% of children with one developmental screening on or before their 1st birthday (12 months of age)
- 70% of children with one developmental screening after their 1st birthday (12 months of age) and on or before their 2nd birthday (24 months of age)
- 65% of children with one developmental screening after their 2nd birthday(24 months of age) and on or before their 3rd birthday (36 months of age)

Measurement Periods: 12 months prior to and inclusive of the 12, 24, or 36 month birthdays, respectively.

Qualifying Service: CPT codes 96110 or 96111. (For more information on qualifying tools review the Healthy Kids Provider Handbook, section HK-203.5.3 and HK-203.5.4 at <u>http://www.hfs.illinois.gov/assets/hk200.pdf</u>).

Qualifying Patient: Any child on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster on December 1, 2013, that turns 12, 24 or 36 months old in that calendar year.
