



## Developmental Screening (2014)

**Benchmarks to qualify for bonus payments:** This measurement has separate benchmarks for different age ranges. The bonus will be determined for each age group independently.

- 90% of children with one developmental screening on or before their 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (12 months of age)
- 80% of children with one developmental screening after their 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (12 months of age) and on or before their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday (24 months of age)
- 75% of children with one developmental screening after their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday (24 months of age) and on or before their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday (36 months of age)

**Measurement Periods:** 12 months prior to and inclusive of the 12, 24, or 36 month birthdays, respectively.

**Qualifying Service:** CPT codes 96110 or 96111. (For more information on qualifying Developmental Screening tools review the HFS Healthy Kids Provider Handbook, section HK203.53 at the following HFS link: <http://www2.illinois.gov/hfs/SiteCollectionDocuments/hk200.pdf>).

**Qualifying Patient:** Any child on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster on December 1, 2013, that turns 12, 24 or 36 months old in that calendar year.
