

Diabetes Management (2013)

Benchmark to qualify for bonus payments: At least 82.38% of patients with diabetes, age 18 to 75 years, had a Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) testing during the measurement year on or before December 31, 2013.

Measurement Period: Calendar year 2013

Qualifying Service: CPT Codes for HbA1c tests 83036 or 83037

Qualifying Patients: Patients on the PCP's Illinois Health Connect panel roster as of December 1, 2013 will be identified as a member with diabetes if they:

- Had two face-to-face encounters with different dates of service in an outpatient/office visit or nonacute inpatient setting with diagnosis of diabetes (ICD-9 codes 250, 357.2, 362.0, 366.41 or 648.0) during the measurement year (CY2013) or the year prior to measurement year (CY2012); or
- Had one face-to-face encounter in an acute inpatient or emergency department (ED) setting with diagnosis of diabetes (ICD-9 codes 250, 357.2, 362.0, 366.41 or 648.0) during the measurement year (CY2013) or the year prior to measurement year (CY2012); or
- Were dispensed insulin or oral hypoglycemic/antihyperglycemics (see listed medications in table below) during the measurement year (CY2013) or the year prior to measurement year (CY2012).
